Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: Typically, from cuttings. From seed, no pretreatment is necessary. "Prepare a seed-starting tray or pots with a well-draining, sterile seed-starting mix. Sow the seeds on the surface of the soil and gently press them down for good seed-to-soil contact. Water the soil thoroughly to maintain consistent moisture without overwatering. Place the container in a sunny location or under grow lights, maintaining a temperature of around 70-75°F (21-24°C). Germination typically occurs within one to two weeks." [Plant Flower Seeds]
