Red Birds in a Tree



Plant type:

Perennial

Season of Interest:

Late spring to frost

Height: 30-48"

Spread: 18-20"

Water needs:

Moderate, low, dry, xeric

Elevation:

to 8125'

Important to know:

Prune to ground in spring. Cut the stems back to 4-6" in midspring when new growth is emerging. Mulch w/ gravel or mulch to conserve moisture



Habitat:

North-facing cliffs and slopes, canyons



Ease of Propagation: Difficult

Propagation: From cuttings, division or seed. Cuttings should be from non-flowering stems, with 2-4 nodes. [Plant Select] For seed, no pretreatment is required. Sow the tiny seeds, cover **very** lightly, and expose to 70°F. [Alplains.com]
