**Habitat:** Shrublands, dry rocky plains, Pinyon-Juniper, deserts



**Ease of Propagation: Easy**  
(if seed viable/fertile)

**Propagation:** Sow in situ or in cells in early spring (late April to mid-May on Front Range). Cover seeds very lightly. Germination in 2 weeks.
