

Solanum rostratum

Buffalo Bur, Spiny Nightshade



Plant type:	Annual (reseeds profusely)
Season of Interest:	Late spring to late summer
Height: 1-4'	Spread: 2-5'
Water needs:	Moderate, low, dry, xeric
Native Region:	CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY
Elevation:	to 8,500'
Important to know:	Highly toxic



Habitat: Fields, pastures, roadsides, disturbed sites



Ease of Propagation: Medium

Propagation: Sow Buffalo Bur seeds in the fall; seeds require exposure to cold temperatures (winter dormancy) before they will germinate.
