## Giant goldenrod, Late goldenrod



Plant type: Rhizomatous perennial Season of Interest: Late summer to early fall

**Height:** 3-7' **Spread:** 2-6' **Water needs:** High, moderate

Native Region: CO, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY

**Elevation:** to 6,000'

**Important to know:** Gigantea tolerates more moisture

than the canadensis; deadhead to

avoid self-seeding.



Maintenance: Low Characteristics: Showy

**Habitat:** Prairie, meadow



**Propagation:** After-ripen by storing dry for 4-6 months. Sow seeds after last frost date. This Solidago likes a bit of moisture, so the medium does not have to be well-draining. Cover very lightly (light requirement). At 70-75°F, seeds germinate in 2-3 weeks.
