

Solidago gigantea

Giant goldenrod, Late goldenrod



Plant type:	Rhizomatous perennial
Season of Interest:	Late summer to early fall
Height: 3-7'	Spread: 2-6'
Water needs:	High, moderate
Native Region:	CO, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY
Elevation:	to 6,000'
Important to know:	Gigantea tolerates more moisture than the canadensis; deadhead to avoid self-seeding.



Maintenance:	Low
Characteristics:	Showy
Habitat:	Prairie, meadow



Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: After-ripen by storing dry for 4-6 months. Sow seeds after last frost date. This Solidago likes a bit of moisture, so the medium does not have to be well-draining. Cover very lightly (light requirement). At 70-75°F, seeds germinate in 2-3 weeks.
