Rocky Mountain Goldenrod



Plant type:	Perennial
Season of Interest:	Mid to late summer
Height: 10-24"	Spread: 8-20"
Water needs:	Moderate, low, dry
Native Region:	CO, AZ, NM, UT, WY
Elevation:	to 13,000'
Important to know:	Great for restoration projects.

Habitat:	Alpine, subalpine, mountain meadows, forests

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Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: After-ripen by storing dry for 4-6 months. Sow seeds after last frost date. Cover very lightly (light requirement). At 70-75°F, seeds germinate in 2-3 weeks. Assuming germination is similar to *S. simplex*, germinates in 7-9 days when sown.
