Munro's Globemallow



Plant type:	Perennial
Season of Interest:	Mid to late summer
Height: 36-42"	Spread: 24"
Water needs:	Low, xeric
Native Region:	UT, WY
Elevation:	to 8,500'
Important to know:	Cut back after flowering to rejuvenate



Maintenance:	Low
Characteristics:	showy, semi-evergreen
Garden uses:	Beds/borders, patio/containers, banks/slopes
Habitat:	Dry plains, mountain slopes, sandy washes



Ease of Propagation: Difficult

Propagation: Store the seeds dry at 40°F. Starting about 8 weeks before the last expected frost, scarify the seeds with sandpaper. Next pour boiling water over the seeds and let the water cool. Soak for 24 hours. Cold stratify for 6 weeks. Sow and cover the seeds very lightly. Expose to 70°F.
