## **Ease of Propagation: Easy**

Propagation: Store dry at 40°F. Sow outdoors in December in situ or cells to achieve temp fluctuations that help break dormancy. One source suggests germination rates improved with mechanical scarification, but seems difficult to achieve on such a tiny seed! Germination late spring. Seedlings are slow to develop but are persistent and drought resistant.
