Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: From stem cuttings or seed. Seed requires cold stratification. Direct sow in fall or earliest spring, or wintersow into pots in the shade, covered with a thin layer of clean sand and a wire screen to keep out mice and voles. Check for water, keeping evenly moist.
