

Verbena stricta

Hoary Verbena/Vervain



Plant type:	Perennial
Season of Interest:	Late spring to fall
Height: 2-4'	Spread: 1'-2'
Water needs:	Average, low
Native Region:	CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY
Elevation:	to 5,700'
Important to know:	Long lasting display, remove spent flowers to prevent unwanted spreading



Maintenance:	Low
Characteristics:	Showy
Garden uses:	Beds/borders
Habitat:	informal, prairie and meadow

Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: store seeds dry at 40°F or 70°F. Cold stratify for 2-5 months either outside (in cells or in situ) or in the fridge. Longer cold stratification provides better germination rate. When sown, cover the seeds very lightly. Germination begins within 9 days.
