

Wyethia amplexicaulis

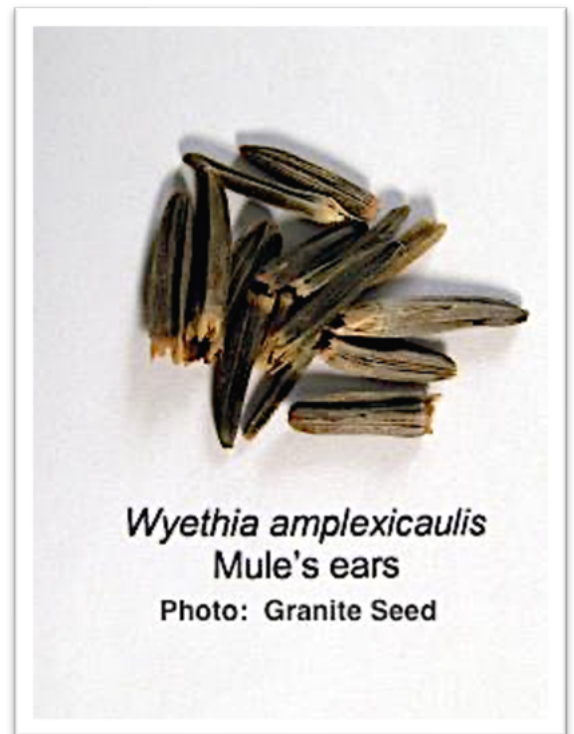
Mule's Ears



Plant type:	Perennial
Season of Interest:	Late spring to mid-summer
Height: 12-32"	Spread: 8-30"
Water needs:	Moderate, low, dry (prefers some moisture)
Native Region:	CO, UT, WY
Elevation:	to 10,500'
Important to know:	Highly competitive spreader; give ample room.



Habitat: Montane, foothills, sagebrush, dry meadows, slopes



Ease of Propagation: Medium

Propagation: Store the seeds dry at 70°F for 6 months. Cold stratify for 90 days either by sowing outside in the winter or by chilling the seeds in the fridge in a moist medium and then sowing in cells. Cover lightly. Seeds germinate at 60-70°F in 2 weeks.
