only pollinator, the Yucca Moth













**Maintenance:** Low

**Characteristics:** showy, evergreen **Garden uses:** Beds/borders

**Habitat:** rock, Mediterranean garden





**Propagation:** Check seeds carefully for insect predation. Discard seeds with holes. Put dry seeds in the freezer for 2 weeks. Sow seeds at 70°F; cover lightly. Seeds will germinate erratically over 3 months. Fall sowing is optimal.
