
Zinnia grandiflora

Plant type: Warm season rhizomatous perennial

Season of Interest: Summer to early fall

Height: 8-10" Spread: 18"+ Water needs: Low, xeric

Native Region: CO, AZ, KS, NM, OK, TX

Elevation: to 7,000'

Important to know: Thrives in hot, dry, challenging garden

spaces. Seed viability rate low at

seed exchanges.



Maintenance: None required Garden uses: ground cover

Habitat: Plains, calcareous/chalky slopes,

mesas





Propagation: No cold stratification is necessary. Sow the seeds in situ or in cells from mid spring to early summer (65-75°F). Cover lightly. Germination may be erratic.
